

Two Truths and A Lie

Time Needed:	10 Minutes
Group Size:	Any
Objectives:	To learn about our classmates, and build positive relationships.
Materials:	Paper, writing utensils for each person.

Recommended Grade:	6+
Activity Description <i>This activity can be used remotely as an icebreaker on a video call to get students more comfortable talking to you and each other on video.</i> <i>Ask students to get out a writing utensil and a small scrap of paper. Ask everyone to write down 3 things about themselves they are comfortable sharing with the class. Think about things that your classmates and friends might not know about you.</i> <i>2 of the sentences must be true 1 sentence must be a lie.</i> <i>The order of the sentences is up to you!</i> <i>Give students some time to write down their sentences. Give a few examples ranging from personal to simple details.</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><i>1. I am allergic to pistachios</i><i>2. I've never travelled outside of Canada</i><i>3. I have 3 younger sisters</i> Students will take turns reading their 3 sentences. Their classmates and you will guess which statement is the LIE. and then they will reveal the lie to them once everyone has guessed
