

How will BRSD keep students and staff safe at school?



Extra Cleaning, Disinfecting and Safety Measures

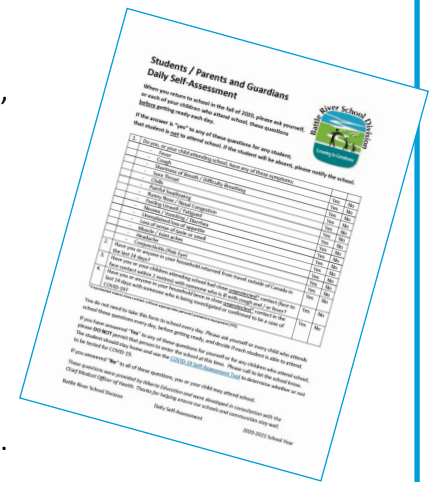
- Additional cleaning during the day.
- Extra attention to ‘high touch’ surfaces.
- “Regular” disinfecting and cleaning done every evening.
- “Soft” fabric furnishings have been removed.
- Air filters will be changed more frequently.
- Water fountains closed and water bottle filling stations installed.



Personal Protective

Equipment will be Provided

- All staff, plus students in Grades 4 to 12, will wear masks.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at all entrances and in every classroom.



Daily Self-Assessments of Health Status

Students / parents and staff will be asked to conduct a daily self-assessment of their health before coming to school. If someone is not well, they must stay home.



Cohorts

Students and teachers will be working in cohorts. A cohort is a group of people who stay together — at school, each cohort will have classes together and breaks together.

High schools are changing to a 1/4 semester system, so students are enrolled in fewer classes at a time.

Limiting interactions between groups

Schools will find ways to ensure there is limited contact between cohorts of students, by limiting larger gatherings and changing some of the school routines.

Each school in Battle River will also have measures in place for entering and moving about their school, to limit student contact. Every school will share details with their families.
